# Ways to register to vote in a federal election

## Register before you go to vote:



#### Online

Visit **elections.ca** and use the **Online Voter Registration Service** to register or update your address information.



### At your local Elections Canada office

Find your local office by using our **Voter Information Service** at **elections.ca** or call us at **1-800-463-6868**.

If you're registered, you should receive a voter information card in the mail after the election is called. It tells you where and when you can vote.

# Register when you go to vote:



### At any Elections Canada office across Canada

Go to any Elections Canada office by the Tuesday before election day, 6:00 p.m. Make sure to bring accepted ID.



### At your assigned polling station

Go to your assigned polling station on election day or advance polling days. Make sure to bring accepted ID.
